Dear Nick:

Consistent with the Southwest Power Pool, Inc. (SPP) EHV Overlay Study, dated March 3, 2008, OG&E hereby commits to construct 765 kV and/or other recommended voltage transmission facilities generally comprised of the following segments.

1. From a new 765 kV substation in Woodward south to Elk City.
2. From a new 765kV substation in Hitchland south to the Texas border.
3. From a new 765kV substation in Hitchland north to the Kansas border.
4. From a new 765 kV substation adjacent to OG&E's Seminole 345 kV substation west towards Lawton.
5. From a new 765 kV substation adjacent to OG&E's Seminole 345 kV substation east and terminating at a new 765kV substation adjacent to OGE's Muskogee 345 kV substation.
6. From a new 765 kV substation adjacent to OG&E's Muskogee 345kV substation north terminating at the Oklahoma – Kansas state line.
7. From a new 765 kV substation adjacent to OG&E's Muskogee 345 kV substation east towards Fort Smith / VBI and terminating at a new 765 kV substation at Fort Smith or VBI.
8. From a new 765kV substation adjacent to Fort Smith / VBI and east towards Arkansas Nuclear One substation.

OG&E further commits to construct any 500 kV lines which interconnect to OG&E's 500 kV substation near Fort Smith Arkansas.

This commitment also includes the construction of under-lying transmission facilities that will be required to support the associated 765 kV and 500 kV facilities.

OG&E's commitment is subject to various approvals of the SPP, state and federal regulatory agencies, and the OGE Energy Corp. Board of Directors. Additionally, our commitment is contingent upon the SPP having a regional cost allocation methodology acceptable to OG&E applicable to these projects.
