Southwest Power Pool has received Point to Point Transmission Service agreements executed by Southwest Public Service Company for the above noted transmission service requests. In the facility study conducted in the assessment of this request, SPP concluded that system upgrades are required on the Kansas City Power and Light Company transmission system as detailed in Aggregate Facility Study SPP-2006-AG2-AFS-4. SPP authorizes KCPL to construct those upgrades to the transmission system concluded in the Facility Study to be necessary to provide the requested transmission service.

SPP authorizes KCPL to upgrade the College – Craig 161kV Ckt 1 facility by reconductoring 4 miles with 1192.5 ACSS and upgrade breaker required by June 1, 2011. This service expedited the need to place this upgrade in service by June 1, 2011 and thus displaced the June 1, 2016 required in service date for KCPL request 1179751 for the Iatan designated resource service.

KCPL shall submit certificate of commercial operation of the listed Network Upgrade to SPP as soon as the upgrade is completed and in service. Please provide SPP with the actual costs of these upgrades as soon as possible after the completion of construction. This will permit SPP to true up billing to actual costs on a timely basis.

Consistent with Section 20.1 of the SPP Tariff, please keep SPP advised of any inability on KCPL's part to complete the upgrades in time to provide the committed service. Provide SPP with the construction schedule supporting the required upgrade noted above within 30 days of receipt of this Transmission System Upgrade Authorization letter. Based on this schedule, SPP will require quarterly updates to the schedule status.
