Dear Mrs. Kentner:

On January 31, 2014, Southwest Power Pool, Inc. (SPP) filed a Meter Agent Services Agreement between Kansas Municipal Energy Agency as the Market Participant and Sunflower Electric Power Corporation as the Meter Agent that does not conform to the standard form of the Meter Agent Services Agreement in SPP Tariff.¹ Pursuant to authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation - Central, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307, the submittal in the above referenced docket is accepted for filing effective January 1, 2014, as requested.

Notice of the filing was published in the Federal Register with interventions or protests due on or before February 21, 2014. No adverse comments or protests were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.

This action does not constitute approval of any service, rate, charge, classification,

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or any rule, regulation, contract, or practice affecting such rate or service provided for in the filed documents; nor shall such action be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation affecting or relating to such service or rate; and such action is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against any of the applicant(s).

This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of the issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713
