Dear Ms. Kenter:

On February 11, 2014, you submitted for filing on behalf of Southwest Power Pool, Inc. (SPP) an executed Interconnection Agreement between Westar Energy, Inc. (Westar) and Prairie Wind Transmission, LLC (Prairie Wind) with SPP as signatory.¹

Notice of the February 11, 2014, filing was published in the Federal Register, 79 Fed Reg 9734 (2014), with comments, protests, or interventions due on or before March 4, 2014. Under 18 C.F.R. § 385.210, interventions are timely if made within the time prescribed by the Secretary. Under 18 C.F.R. § 385.214, the filing of a timely motion to intervene makes the movant a party to the proceeding, if no answer in opposition is filed within fifteen days. No adverse comments or protests were received.

Pursuant to authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation-Central, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307, your submittal in the above reference docket is accepted for filing effective April 13, 2014.

This action does not constitute approval of any service, rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, contract, or practice affecting such rate or service provided for in the filed documents; nor shall such action be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation affecting or relating to such service or rate; and such action
