Dear Ms. Kentner:

On February 20, 2014, Southwest Power Pool, Inc. (SPP) filed an executed Meter Agent Services Agreement (Agreement) between Kansas Power Pool as market participant and Westar Energy, Inc. as meter agent.<sup>1</sup> Pursuant to authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation – Central, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307, the Agreement submitted in the above-referenced docket is accepted for filing, effective February 1, 2014, as requested.

Notice of SPP's filing was issued, with comments, protests, or interventions due on or before March 13, 2014. Under 18 C.F.R. § 385.210, interventions are timely if made within the time prescribed by the Secretary. Under 18 C.F.R. § 385.214, the filing of a timely motion to intervene makes the movant a party to the proceeding, if no answer in opposition is filed within fifteen days. The filing of a timely notice of intervention makes a State Commission a party to the proceeding. No responsive filings were received.

This action does not constitute approval of any service, rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, contract, or practice affecting such rate or service provided for in the filed document; nor shall such action be deemed as recognition of any claimed

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contractual right or obligation affecting or relating to such service or rate; and such action is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against any of the applicants.

This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
