Submission of Notice of Cancellation of Ancillary Services Agreement
and Distribution Facilities

Dear Secretary Bose:

Pursuant to section 35.15 of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission's ("Commission") regulations, 18 C.F.R. § 35.15, Southwest Power Pool, Inc. ("SPP") submits this filing to notify the Commission of the cancellation of an Ancillary Services Agreement and Distribution Facilities among SPP as Transmission Provider, Kansas Power Pool ("KPP") as Transmission Customer, and Westar Energy, Inc. ("Westar") as Transmission Owner ("Agreement").¹ SPP respectfully requests that the Commission accept the cancellation of the Agreement effective March 1, 2014.

I. Background and Notice of Cancellation

On September 2, 2008, SPP filed the Agreement with the Commission in Docket No. ER08-1487-000. The Commission accepted the Agreement on October 28, 2008.² Section 3.0 of the Agreement provides that the Agreement may be terminated by the "mutual consent of the Parties." With the implementation of SPP's Integrated Marketplace on March 1, 2014, the Parties determined that the Agreement was obsolete and mutually agreed to terminate the Agreement. Because the Agreement was filed with the Commission, SPP submits this notice of cancellation to the Commission.

II. Effective Date and Waiver

SPP requests an effective date of March 1, 2014 for the cancellation of the Agreement. To permit such an effective date, SPP also requests a waiver of the Commission's sixty day notice requirement.³ Good cause exists for such a waiver because March 1, 2014 is the date the Agreement became obsolete due to the implementation of the Integrated Marketplace. In addition, March 1, 2014 is the date the Parties mutually agreed for termination of the Agreement to become effective.
