On April 28, 2014, Southwest Power Pool, Inc. (SPP) submitted for filing an executed Meter Agent Services Agreement between Kansas Municipal Energy Agency as the Market Participant and Sunflower Electric Power Corporation as the Meter Agent. Pursuant to authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation – Central under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307, your submittal in the above referenced docket is accepted for filing to be effective April 1, 2014, as requested.¹

Notice of the filing was issued with comments, protests, or interventions due on or before May 19, 2014. No protests were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214). 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any findings or orders which have been or may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against your Company.

Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
