Dear Ms. Kentner:

On May 7, 2014, Southwest Power Pool, Inc. (SPP) filed an executed Generator Interconnection Agreement (GIA)¹ among SPP as Transmission Provider, Rattlesnake Creek Wind Project, LLC (Rattlesnake) as Interconnection Customer, and Nebraska Public Power District (NPPD) as Transmission Owner (Agreement). SPP also filed a Notice of Cancellation of a previous GIA (Third Revised Service Agreement No. 2299) among SPP, Rattlesnake and NPPD. Pursuant to authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation – Central, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307, the Agreement in the above referenced docket is accepted for filing, effective April 9, 2014, as requested. In addition, notice that the Third Revised Service Agreement No. 2299 is cancelled is accepted effective April 9, 2014.

Notice of the filing was issued with comments, protests, or interventions due on or before May 28, 2014. Under 18 C.F.R § 385.210, interventions are timely if made within the time prescribed by the Secretary. Under 18 C.F.R. § 385.214, the filing of a timely motion to intervene makes the movant a party to the proceeding, if no answer in opposition is filed within fifteen days. The filing of a timely notice of intervention makes a State Commission a party to the proceeding. No adverse comments were filed.
