Dear Ms. Kentner:

On April 3, 2015, Southwest Power Pool, Inc. (SPP), submitted for filing a Meter Agent Services Agreement¹ between RMA Access, LLC and Westar Energy, Inc. SPP requests waiver of the Commission's notice requirements. Waiver of the 60-day prior notice requirement is granted pursuant to section 35.11 of the Commission's Regulations² and SPP's Meter Agent Services Agreement is accepted, to become effective April 1, 2015, as requested.

Docket No. ER15-1450-000 was noticed on April 3, 2015, with comments, protests or interventions due on or before April 24, 2015. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214) of the Commission's Regulations. Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.

This action does not constitute approval of any service, rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, contract, or practice affecting such rate or service provided for in the filed documents; nor shall such action be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation affecting or relating to such service or rate; and such action is without
