Submission of Notice of Cancellation of Firm Point-To-Point  
Transmission Service Agreement

Dear Secretary Bose:

Pursuant to section 35.15 of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission's ("Commission") regulations, 18 C.F.R. § 35.15, Southwest Power Pool, Inc. ("SPP") submits this filing to notify the Commission of the cancellation of a service agreement for Firm Point-To-Point Transmission Service ("PTP Agreement") between SPP as Transmission Provider and City of Independence, Missouri ("Independence") as Transmission Customer ("Independence PTP Agreement").<sup>1</sup>

### **I. Background and Notice of Cancellation**

On June 7, 2007, in Docket No. ER07-736-001,<sup>2</sup> SPP filed the Independence PTP Agreement because it did not conform to the form of PTP Agreement set forth in the SPP FERC Electric Tariff in effect on that date.<sup>3</sup> On August 10, 2007, the Commission issued an Order accepting the Independence PTP Agreement effective June 1, 2010.<sup>4</sup> The Independence PTP Agreement has since been replaced and superseded by a Network

Integration Transmission Service Agreement and Network Operating Agreement, designated as Original Service Agreement No. 3015 (collectively, the “Service Agreement No. 3015”), which conform to the standard forms of service agreements set forth in the SPP Open Access Transmission Tariff (“SPP Tariff”);<sup>5</sup> and, therefore, will be reported solely in SPP’s electric quarterly report commencing in the second quarter of 2015.<sup>6</sup>

Because the Independence PTP Agreement was filed with the Commission and has been replaced by the conforming Service Agreement No. 3015, SPP is submitting this notice of cancellation to the Commission.

## **II. Effective Date and Waiver**

SPP requests an effective date of June 1, 2015, for the cancellation of the Independence PTP Agreement. To permit such an effective date, SPP also requests a waiver of the Commission’s sixty day notice requirement.<sup>7</sup> Good cause exists for such a waiver because June 1, 2015 is the effective date of Service Agreement No. 3015 that superseded and replaced the Independence PTP Agreement.

## **III. Service**

SPP is serving a copy of this filing on the representatives listed in the Independence PTP Agreement.
