By letter dated August 17, 1999, you submitted for filing with the Commission, on behalf of the Southwest Power Pool (SPP) revisions to SPP's open access transmission tariff. The submittal is accepted for filing effective August 18, 1999, and is designated as shown on the Enclosure.

Notice of the filing was published in the Federal Register with comments, protests, or interventions due on or before September 9, 1999. Dynegy Power Marketing, Inc. filed a motion to intervene. Under Rule 214(c) (1) of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedures (18 CFR 385.214), the unopposed timely motion to intervene serves to make movant a party to this proceeding.

This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 CFR 385.713.
