Dear Mr. Berman:

By letter dated August 31, 1999, you submitted for filing with the Commission, on behalf of the Southwest Power Pool, Inc. (SPP), revisions to SPP's open access transmission tariff to price short-term firm and nonfirm services on the basis of the open access rate of the transmission provider where the load is located. Your submittal is accepted for filing effective November 1, 1999, and is designated as shown on the Enclosure.

Notice of the filing was published in the Federal Register with comments, protests, or interventions due on or before September 20, 1999. Timely motions to intervene were filed by Kansas Electric Power Cooperative, Inc., Golden Spread Electric Cooperative, Inc., Arkansas Electric Cooperative Corporation, Dynegy Power Marketing, Inc., Enron Power Marketing, Inc., Western Resources, Inc. and Duke Energy Trading & Marketing, L.L.C. Pursuant to Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 CFR 385.214), the timely, unopposed interventions serve to make these movants parties to this proceeding. On September 21, 1999, Southwestern Electric Power Company (SWEPCO) and Public Service Company of Oklahoma (PSO) filed an untimely motion to intervene. SWEPCO and PSO's motion to intervene is granted.

This action does not constitute approval of any service, rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, contract, or practice affecting such rate or service provided for in the filed documents; nor shall such action be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation affecting or relating to such service or rate; and such action

is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against the Southwest Power Pool, Inc.
