("SPP") Membership Agreement and Attachments O and Y of the SPP Open Access Transmission Tariff ("OATT"), on February 22, 2017 SPP issued a Notification to Construct ("NTC") No. 200444 directing Southwestern Public Service Company ("SPS"), as the Designated Transmission Owner, to construct the specified Network Upgrades.


