**Action Item:** Bring back percentages between the “with” and “without” values. For example, 25%, 50%, and 75% for the cold-weather related outages.

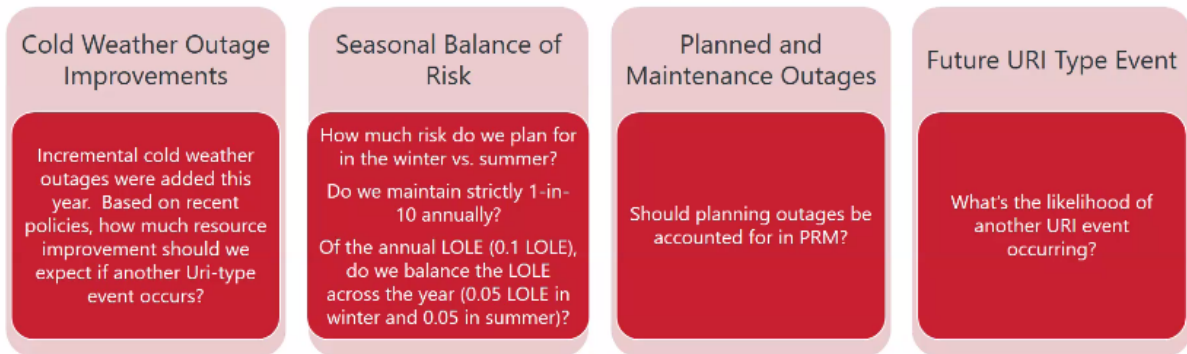
Some questions for SAWG to discuss/consider:

1. How likely is that event to occur again?
2. If that event occurred again, would units perform just as poorly?
3. What level of LOLE is acceptable for the winter vs the summer LOLE level?
4. Should the failure of certain types of resources be socialized in a PRM for everyone, or should they be addressed through accreditation of the offending units?

5. How much excess capacity and what cost do we require to mitigate a winter storm Uri event or a summer like 1980 or 2012?
6. What are the PRM values for less than 100% cold-weather related outages?

Other important questions that will determine the PRM level for summer and winter.
