Southwest Power Pool, Inc.

On June 13, 2024, Southwest Power Pool, Inc. (SPP) submitted: (1) a Network Integration Transmission Service Agreement between SPP as transmission provider and Western Farmers Electric Cooperative (WFEC) as network customer; (2) a Network Operating Agreement (NOA) among SPP as transmission provider, WFEC as network customer, and WFEC, Oklahoma Gas and Electric Company, American Electric Power Service Corporation, and Southwestern Public Service Company as host transmission owners; and (3) a NOA among SPP as transmission provider, WFEC as network customer, and Southwestern Power Administration as host transmission owner.¹ SPP requested that the filing be accepted effective June 1, 2024. Pursuant to authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation – Central, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307, the submittal is accepted for filing, effective June 1, 2024, as requested.²

The filing was publicly noticed. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Pursuant to Rule 214 of the Commission’s regulations (18 C.F.R. § 385.214), notices of intervention, timely-filed motions to intervene, and any unopposed motions to intervene out-of-time filed before the issuance date of this order are granted.

This action does not constitute approval of any service, rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, contract, or practice affecting such rate or service provided for in the filed document(s); nor shall such action be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation affecting or relating to such service or rate; and such action is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against the applicant(s).
